Course Overview

With the introduction of Benedict's Law which sets out mandatory, statutory allergy safety requirements for schools in England, it is essential that staff and volunteers in school and education settings have the knowledge and confidence to respond quickly and appropriately when an allergy related emergency occurs.

This qualification prepares Learners to recognise, manage and respond effectively to allergy-related incidents and medical emergencies, including anaphylaxis and asthma attacks.

Designed for all staff and volunteers working in schools and education settings who may be required to recognise allergic reactions, and who have a responsibility for the care, supervision and safety of children and young people.
